The CalWORKs program assists students to transition from public assistance to economic self-sufficiency (employment) through educational attainment.

### Services Provided:

- Priority Registration
- Book Assistance\*
- Career Development
- Bus Passes and/or Gas Cards\*
- Work Study Programs\*
- Student Educational Planning
- University Campus Visits\*

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Two-parent or single parent households
- Parent(s) and child must be a CalWORKs/TANF recipient
- Approved County Welfare to WORK (WTW) plan
- No unit minimum
