- Participating businesses receive a window cling (sign) to advertise their participation in the RFFB program
- Participating businesses are recognized on www.kcdhs.org and introduced in the **Fostering Families Today** magazine
- Resource families show their RFFB member card to qualify
- A directory of participating businesses will be provided to over 1,025 resource family households serving close to 2,000 foster children
